

Minutes of the meeting of Seaton Ross Parish Council held on

Friday 26 June 2020

A Parish Council meeting was held by Skype on 26 June 2020 at 7.30pm.

19/20 **Declarations of interest** – None.

20/20 **Minutes** - Agreed that the minutes of the meeting held on 5 June 2020 be approved as a correct record and be signed by the Chairman.

21/20 **Planning application 20/01699/PLF – Change of use of land for storage and distribution and haulage yard (retrospective application) - Land South West Of Dial Farm Seaton Common Lane** - Agreed that comments be submitted requesting a condition that hours of use are limited to those at Rolawn, if planning permission is granted.

22/20 **Footpaths South End and Church Lane** – Councillors discussed the poor state of the footpaths – Agreed that the Clerk report the poor state of the footpaths to East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

23/20 **Planters** – the planters had now been repaired and strengthened.

24/20 **Village Plot** – Agreed that Mr E Gardham be asked to tidy up the parish plot and paid for his work.

25/20 **Area behind the telephone box** – nettles were overgrowing the footpath – Agreed that the Chairman contact the land owner to discuss.

26/20 **Speeding in the village** – there had been no volunteers to set up a community speeding scheme. The Parish Council said it would support such a scheme but it was for volunteers from the parish to lead on it, not the Parish Council. Agreed that the Clerk request East Riding of Yorkshire Council consider whether to extend the 30mph zone coming into the village from Ash Lane.

27/20 **Facebook Community Group** – Agreed that the Chairman and Clerk would, where required, provide a response on behalf of the Parish Council to comments on the community page.

28/20 **Duke of Edinburgh** – a parishioner, who was taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh scheme had asked if they could carry out regular litter picking in the parish – Agreed with the proviso the parishioner would need to ensure they had the appropriate insurance.
