- 8/20 Declarations of interest None.
- 9/20 Minutes Agreed that the minutes of the meeting held on 15 May 2020 be approved as a correct record and be signed by the Chairman.
- **10/20 Defibrillator** Cllr Gascoyne had renewed the pads and put a sign in the box asking anyone who used the defibrillator to contact him as new pads were required each time it was used.
- 11/20 Public Right of Way from Damson Cottage, South End a parishioner had reported the fence on one side of the path had bowed out causing a partial obstruction to the path. Agreed that the Clerk investigate and if necessary, speak to the householder.
- 12/20 Speeding on Mill Lane and North End councillors had received reports of speeding. The community speeding scheme was discussed and it was agreed to return to this subject once lockdown had ended. Agreed that an item be included in the Seaton Ross Times asking people to report vehicles speeding to the police (number plate would be required).
- 13/20 Parish Plot the parishioner who had agreed to take over maintenance of the parish plot was now unable to do so. Agreed that an item be placed in the Seaton Ross Times asking for volunteers.
- 14/20 Planters the base of the planter on South End had broken. Agreed that Clir Wealleans would remove the plants and soil and Clir Henley would contact Men in Sheds, who made the planters, and ask them to mend the broken base.
- **15/20** Map of Seaton Ross The History Group had draw up a map showing the location of houses in Seaton Ross Agreed that the Parish Council send a letter of thanks to Mr Hales for his hard work and offer to pay for the printing of further maps if required.
- 16/20 Covid-19 Village Support Agreed that Cllr Henley would place an item in the Seaton Ross Times, reminding people how to contact the support group.
- 17/20 Willow Tree, The Gables a parishioner had reported the tree as a potential safety hazard. Agreed that the Clerk report the issue to East Riding of Yorkshire Council.
